## This week: "Did you know?"

If you've got a guitar that's out of tune, Kim Jones can feel it in her teeth. "Bay Music! Been here 7 years!" Inspired by the Beverly Hillbillies and Earl Skruggs, Kim spotted a banjo in a military PX in England when she was eight years old. Buying it with her own savings, she played in the UK, moved to New York, then on to Monroe, Louisiana where she rode a horse into town for lessons.

Kim retired from touring at 16 after she began seeing drugs and alcohol at events. Raised Southern Baptist, that scene wasn't for Kim. She had made enough money to pay for college, and now Kim enjoys playing at festivals with her electrified banjo.

Kim holds two PhD's: One in analytical biochemistry and another in reproductive physiology. "I deal with and am involved with people who are involved with livestock, roughstock cattle, bucking bulls." \*\*\*Ask to see the adorable baby pictures and majestic grown-up images of Anfractuious and Buster! \*\*\* She taught high school and college science, is a licensed high school administrator, and still owns a feed store back in Louisiana. She travels to Branson Missouri on a regular basis playing bluegrass.

How did she get to Fairhope? "I had some very serious surgery and I came down to recuperate with some friends who were retired physicians in Gulf Shores. I liked the area so well I never went home."

Formerly a teacher for Jubilee Music, Kim took over the business and now she and her crew teach over 100 students six days and evenings a week in Fairhope. "Some of our

students don't speak English, and we have around 20 students with disabilities. I had an older student who had a stroke and was blind. Her goal was to play a song for her Sunday School class, and we were able to help her learn to do that by feel."

According to Kim, "We work with the VA, also an association in FL that deals with trafficking. There's a tremendous need for donated instruments for disabled kids, abused kids, soldiers with PTSD... We do a lot of buyouts of stores across the country, overseas, we sell to universities, militaries that have marching bands that cannot afford to buy name brand instruments..."

"Everybody has music in them. Everybody. It might not be guitar or piano, but everybody's got it. Music is a language. It does two things: It moves up and it moves down. Whole steps and half steps. You only got eight notes. Now what can I do with eight notes? People have been writing music since before Jesus was born, yet everyday we have new music that comes out."

"Fairhope is home. I like the town. I like the people. I like the atmosphere. I like everything about it. I figured it out real fast."

"Mom always said you come in as a customer, you leave as family. That's how it is!"
