This week: Did You Know?

Fairhope's "Mule Mix" is for bars, not barnyards!

Ryan Mueller of the Fairhope Snack Company says the one frequent (and frankly hilarious) misconception about the company's signature snack, Mule Mix, is "Is it for animals?" Well, it depends on how you refer to your friends and family...

Born in Fairhope in 1983, with a degree from Auburn in industrial design, no matter where he lived or traveled, Ryan, aka. "Mule," always knew he was coming home. He bought and is restoring his grandparents' home at Fairhope and Blue Island Avenues, and says his days are carved out according to which delivery area he's servicing - Mobile is Tuesdays, the beaches are Thursdays, Friday is drop-ship day, etc... Even Park City, Utah is selling Mule Mix, y'all!

Did Mule always know he was going to be an entrepreneur with a snack mix? No. "It was just something that happened. Mom made it for the holidays and events growing up, and I tweaked it and made it for a wedding, then for some friends' weddings..." A conversation one evening with Jessica Guthrie and an offer to use the facilities at Rae's Kitchen was the tipping point that launched Ryan's "Mule's Mix" from daydream to day-reality. "I don't think she thought I was serious, but I'm like yeah, I'm doing this. I wasn't expecting it, but it just took off."

Mueller now utilizes the kitchen and chef expertise after-hours at Julwin's, and can hardly cook and cool the batches fast enough to meet demand.

His advice to budding entrepreneurs: "The hardest part is making the decision to do it. Just saying, 'Yes.' You think the hardest part is going to be the permits and paperwork - the ins-and-outs seem daunting, but that's actually the simplest part. You just fill out the forms. It takes less than two hours, less than \$2K, and you have a business."

Small business runs in the family, as Ryan's brother Robbie is known as "Rent The Lights." Ryan's secret ingredient: "My mom. She keeps me organized and on track. She keeps tabs on the books and tells me when it's time to do taxes."

Insider scoop! The Fairhope Snack Company plans to launch a new product, a beef jerky called "Cowboy Food" inspired by Mueller's ancestors from Champaign, Illinois, who traveled with their own jerky by the same name.
